-  Training support via phone/email from Trainer






## Entry Requirements

All entrants must be a **minimum of 18 years of age** at the time of enrolment. Parker Brent will ensure the program is suitable to your needs, skills and experience.

Prospective students must be able to demonstrate that they are genuinely interested in undertaking a course in building surveying, have a **minimum** of 5 years' experience working at a **supervisory level** (such as builder, site manager etc.) in the building and construction industry, and/or the course aligns with their career outlook.

Students will be required to have:

-  Suitable level of English language, literacy and numeracy skills
-  A current Construction Induction Card (White Card)
-  Access to a building and construction project worksite or access to the Parker Brent Simulated Working Environment in Lalor
